The members applauded Sheri McAlister and John Weil thanking them for their service as Treasurer and Director, respectively.

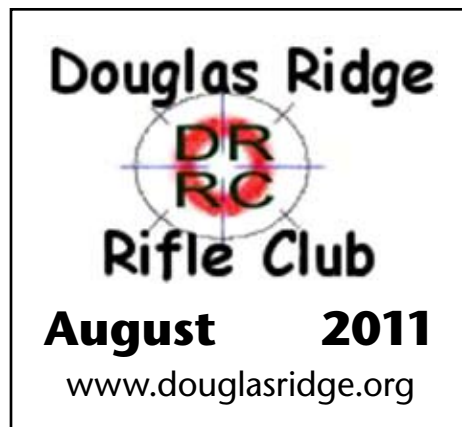
## Opportunities To Help And Who To Contact

## Discipline Director Updates

Most Discipline Directors gave reports of their activities at the Annual Meeting on July 7th. The following is a summary of those reports:

**Adult Small Bore:** Bob Stevens reported that ASB will be starting in November, and shooting into early April. Matches will be Friday evenings, with about a dozen at DRRC.

**Black Powder Cartridge Rifle:** Bob Anderson stated that about a dozen shooters are participating. Eight of them traveled to Montana for the Quigley shoot, which got rained out. They are building gongs and silhouette targets. Normal shooting is the 2nd Tuesday of each month.

**Blackpowder Muzzleloader:** Steve Irving said that they had a small turnout in June, but that a new shooter has joined the group and is having good fun.

**Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP):** Charlie McAlister reported that the first cross-course match would be next weekend, and another cross-course match will be held in August. Todd Hanson and Mark Edwards will be taking over this discipline as Charlie steps aside after several years running it.

**Handgun Silhouette:** Greg Watson stated that there are no matches in July and August due to Long Range events. The discipline has some new people and there is more interest. The next match is the 1st Sunday in September.

**Hunter Safety:** Bill Hendrix and

Larry Warren had three classes at DRRC with a total of 73 students. They taught a class in February, and a Master Hunter class in April. They are currently in process with a home study class. Next Hunter Safety classes will be in 2012.

**Junior Shotgun:** Dick Jennings is working with about a dozen kids. They are doing well, and getting ready for state competitions.

**USPSA:** Dan Carpenter was not able to be at the meeting, Mark Edwards said that 20 shooters were at the last match. As a first time participant at USPSA, Mark found it great fun. He said the group was very helpful.

**Ladies Pistol:** John Weil reported that they just completed their first class with the new 4-week format, and it went well. The next class is in October. There are openings in the February 2012 class, and interested ladies can sign up on-line.

## Targets Reminder

With some good weather finally arriving, more members are getting out to shoot. And due to some poor choices by someone to shoot pop cans at the Tactical Shotgun Bay, we must remind all of you about the rule regarding targets. From the Member Handbook:

*Targets - Only paper targets (and steel reactionary at the silhouette range) are allowed on DRRC firing ranges. There are exceptions to this rule for some disciplines and some ranges. Do not use cans, bottles, plastic jugs, etc. as targets.*

Failure to follow DRRC rules could result in disciplinary action. The Board reminds all members that we are self-policing, and if

you observe someone breaking our rules, ask them to stop and get their name and member number. Report rule infractions to the Discipline Director, Range Safety Officer, Range Host, or a Board Member.
