Discipline Day

As discussed two months ago, we are planning a Discipline Day on Saturday July 31st to introduce several of our shooting disciplines to members who may be interested. Five Disciplines are scheduled to participate in Discipline Day. They are Handgun Silhouette, Black Powder Muzzleloaders, CMP (Military Rifles), USPSA/IPSC (Practical Pistol) and Black Powder Cartridge. This event is open to all members, at no charge. That includes Associates and Juniors. Members may bring guests, by paying the usual guest fees. This is an opportunity to learn about some of our

organized shooting sports, and to meet people who have similar interests in these activities.

Set-up and check-in will begin at 8 a.m. There will be three sets of rotations, at 9, 10 and 11 a.m. Each rotation will consist of an introduction to the discipline, a presentation of the firearms used, and an opportunity to shoot. You do not need to bring your own guns; the disciplines will have guns and ammo for you to shoot. You may use your own guns and ammo, at the discretion of the Discipline Director.
